Dear National Federation,

Please, find attached the specific regulations for the Finswimming FISU World Cup 2022 in Lignano next 1st and 2nd April 2022.

As you know, this is the visualization of the hard work realized by CMAS with the International Sport University Federation. We pass through a new important step with this FISU competition.

CMAS has signed a contract with FISU for the World Cups 2022 and 2024. The next goal is to receive an agreement for a University Finswimming World championships, but 2022 and 2024 must be a success to achieve it.

Consequently, as National Federation, I kindly ask you to promote in your country this competition. For this, you need first to contact your National University Federation urgently to coordinate with them to participate in this competition.

Then, promote it in the regions, clubs, and with the athletes to push Universities to organize this. Indeed, as you can see in the document attached, it's the responsibility of your national university federation to register the participants in the FISU platform of registration; this basically stays with the Universities because the participation is by University and not National Teams.

The registration has been open since October 1st. Please, when you discuss with your national university federation, pay attention to the different deadlines for the registration.

Please, spread this information to the maximum amount of people you are in connection with.
