## 1. Welcome messages

The French Federation FFESSM – authorised by CMAS– invites all interested Federations and Clubs to participate in the 2026 CMAS World Cup Finswimming Indoor organised from 24th to 26th April 2026 in Aix en Provence, France.

## 2. Presentation of the Host City

Situated on highway A7 and route N7, 35 km from Marseille, 15 km from Aix TGV railway station and 30 km from Marseille Provence International Airport. Protected by the Montagne Sainte Victoire which rises to 1,011m. Aix with ancient fountains and shaded narrow streets is surrounded by a countryside full of old Provençal houses and traditional French style gardens. Aix was the capitol of Provence in the 15th century. Wealthy merchants and local dignitaries helped turn this city into the Florence of Provence as we know it today. Aix was the inspiration to many of the greatest writers and painters: Giono, Stendhal, Mistral, Zola, Van Gogh, Renoir and Cézanne.

- Number of spectators: 1000

- The judges are authorised to check swimmers' equipment at any time during the competitions.
- The swimmers must be available for the Start Judge with their full equipment at least 10 minutes before the race starts.
- Any equipment that does not comply with EN250 will not be allowed (Only medium pressure pipes (MP) to French standards mechanically crimped at the ends will be allowed). Clamps of "Serflex" type or other similar devices are forbidden.

#### Doping Control

The Organising Committee guarantees to provide doping control according to the CMAS and WADA rules during the championship and regarding the number of tests planned by ITA.

#### Classification and Awards

The classifications will be based on times registered by the timekeepers. The results will be compiled according to CMAS score and CMAS World Cup classification.

There will be classifications for Individuals, Clubs, National Teams and Countries

#### **Individual:**

There will be, for every distance, four different individual classifications for Senior and Junior, men and women. Swimmers registered by Clubs or National Teams are in this classification.

#### **Club:**

The general classification will be made by the total number of individual points (men and women, junior and senior only registered by clubs). Four separate Club Classification will be made also for senior men, senior women, junior boys and junior girls.

#### **National Teams:**

The general classification will be made by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior). Four separate National Teams Classification will be made also for men, women, junior boys and junior girls.

### Countries Ranking:

The Countries' Ranking will be made following points 1.10 and 1.13 by the total number of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior) of National Teams.

If a National Federation does not enrol its national team, the best two results by club following points 1.10 and 1.13 at each distance, at each category (men, women, junior and senior) will go for the Countries ranking.

- Individual prizes: medals will be given to the first three classified athletes in every individual race and every relay.
- Team prizes: Cups for the first three clubs and Cups for the first three National Teams.
- Awarding ceremonies will take place during the competition, so the athletes involved must be at the organising staff's disposal at the right time.

## 8. Financial Modalities

### A) CMAS Fees

For each round, in order to participate, each competitor is required to pay through the CMAS Portal the CMAS fees fixed annually by CMAS.

- 25,50 € for participation fees by each round for 2026.

**Note that the names of relay members must be entered during the registration process on the base of individual registration even if they only swim relay and even according to the rules, the composition of relays can be changed on site before the beginning of competition.**

The CMAS fees will be paid only at the end of the registration process online, by credit card.

### B) Miscellaneous

- Fees will not be refunded for non-participation of athletes in races.
- Penalties will apply for late enrolments after the deadline according to the registration planning.

### C) Organisation Fees

The organisation fees are paid directly to the organising committee according to the instructions communicated below.

Inscription fees for 2026 are:

For each club;

- 25,80 € for each club;
- 18,30 € for each relay
- 10,20 € for each individual distance

The CMAS and Participation fees will **not** be refunded for non-participation of athletes in races.
